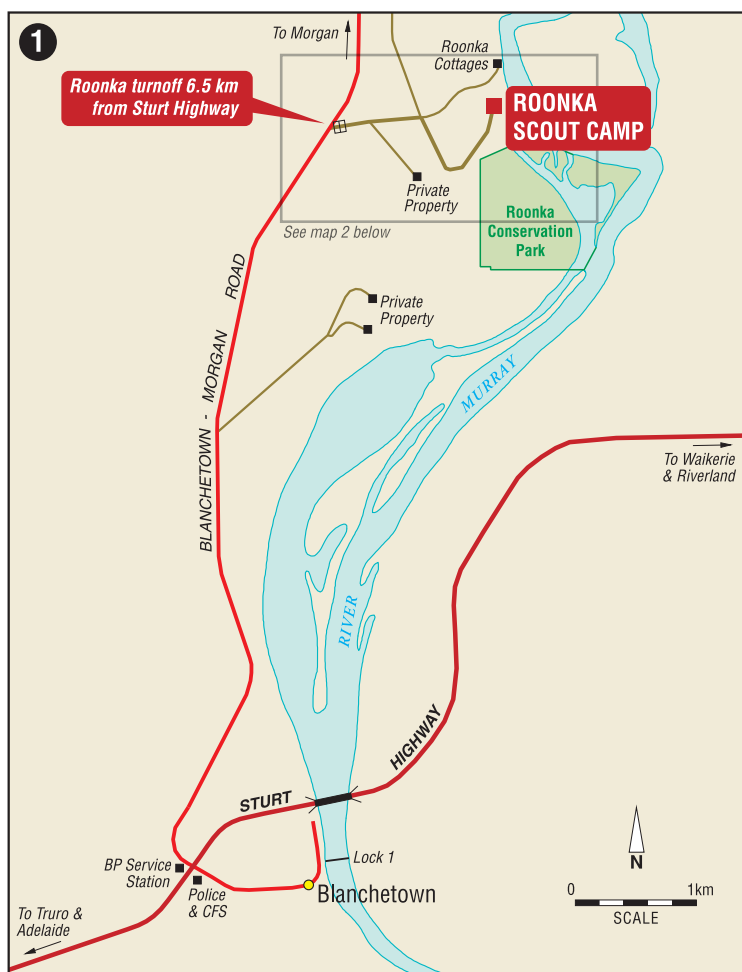

How to get to Roonka

Located approximately 7 kilometres north of Blanchetown on the banks of the River Murray.

- From Adelaide, travel to Blanchetown along the Sturt Highway (A20) via Truro
- On Map 1, turn left on to the Blanchetown to Morgan Road next to the BP Service Station (before crossing the river)
- Travel approximately 6.5km along this sealed road
- Look for "Roonka Scout Camp" sign on the left hand side
- Further along on the right side of the road there are two signs, "Roonka Holiday Cottages" and "Scouts"
- On Map 2, turn right on to this unsealed road and cross two cattle grids (following the yellow highlighted route) and proceed to the "Scout" sign just before a third cattle grid (approximately 750 metres)
- Turn right and proceed down the hill until you reach our first gate
- Proceed through the gate and continue to the second gate (next to this gate is a private residence so please be as quiet as possible if arriving at night)
- The gate may be open or closed – proceed through – following signs to "Wardens Cottage" for booking in and allocation of a camping site or bunkhouse
- Park vehicles in the car park after you are settled in
